Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must:

- Be a resident or actively engaged in one of NORSAAC's operational regions (priority given to Northern Ghana)
- Be affiliated with a youth-led or youth-focused initiative, organization, or movement
- Have management experience (preferred but not mandatory)

Required Experience & Skills

- Proven experience in youth mobilization, advocacy, gender equity, or civic engagement
- Ability to represent diverse youth interests, especially those of marginalized or underserved groups
- Experience in policy dialogue, community organizing, or strategic influencing
- Strong commitment to NORSAAC's mission and values
- Capacity to contribute to board-level discussions on governance, resource allocation, and program oversight
- Excellent communication and documentation skills

Role & Commitment



- Serve a three-year term on the Board of Directors
- Participate regularly in **board meetings** and **strategic planning sessions**
- Act as a liaison between the board and broader youth networks
- Dedicate time to **mentorship**, **capacity-building**, and **feedback loops** with youth constituencies

CRITERIA SELECTION

1. Eligibility

- Aged between 18-35 years
- Resident or actively engaged in one of NORSAAC's operational regions (priority shall be for Northern Ghana)
- Affiliated with a youth-led or youth-focused initiative, organization, or movement
- I should have some years' management experience. This is relevant but not a must

2. Leadership & Advocacy Experience

- Proven track record in youth mobilization, advocacy, gender equity, or civic engagement
- Demonstrated ability to represent diverse youth interests, especially marginalized or underserved groups
- Experience in policy dialogue, community organizing, or strategic influencing

3. Values Alignment

 Commitment to NORSAAC's mission, especially around social justice, inclusion, and responsiveness.

4. Strategic Thinking & Accountability

- Ability to contribute meaningfully to board-level discussions on governance, resource allocation, and program oversight
- Strong documentation and communication skills, ability to draft reports, position papers, or represent youth perspectives in external forums

5. Inclusivity & Representation

 Willingness to serve as a liaison between the board and broader youth networks

6. Commitment & Availability

- Willingness to serve a defined term (3 years) with regular participation in board meetings and strategic planning sessions
- Ability to commit time for mentorship, capacity-building, and feedback loops with youth constituencies
